

## 11th Grade Calendar for ACP/Advisory Lessons

September-Be Responsible-Review Student Handbook and School Policies  
Leadership Training Attend the WEF College Fair at UW-RC Review the fair with your advisory. Attend college counselor visits at Weston Schools.

October-Be Safe-Review Bullying and Harassment Be Respectful-How to be a respectful student, athlete participant or fan. Completing volunteer hours and service. School and community organizations.

November-What are Scholarships? ACP-Revisit Career Matchmaker assessment and answer additional 58 questions. Complete School Selector questionnaire; save at least one school and one major of interest. Review Schools of interest in Education section of Career Cruising. Save an additional school of interest either Technical College, or University.

December-ACP-Click on My Plan, then click on My Goals and Plans, then click on Career and Life Goals Review and update these plans. Click on Career Planning Activities. Select an Activity from drop down (job shadowing, etc) Complete at least two job shadows during the school year. Write up a summary and place them in this section.

Continue to build and explore your Career and Educational Goals and Financial Plans.

January-ACP-Share your Plan with the rest of your Advisory. Invite your Advisory teacher to review your plan and share with your advisory  
Review the 4 year planner and course selections with the Counselor.

February-ACP-Add extra-curricular activities to My Plan. Update your portfolio to include community service, volunteer hours, work experience and clubs and organizations. Add a new skill to My Plan.

Organize work experience for the summer. Review School to work experience and placement for Senior year.

Take the ACT

March-ACP Use the Resume Builder to update your resume. Review the results of the ACT. What is the ACT impact on college selection. Under Education review College requirements and college timeline.

April/May-ACP Use Resume Builder to write a cover letter. Also learn to write scholarship letters. Look for references for college applications. Update long term or short term goals for senior year. Attend job shadows. Write up job shadow in My Plan. Visit technical colleges or universities.
